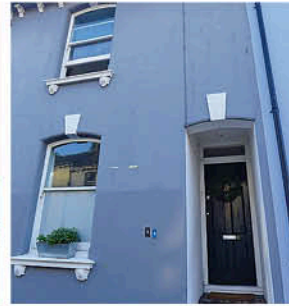




Clockwise from left: Winsome and Saucy necklace knits; Hello Dodo print; AT Open House opens its doors; and Delicious Industries notebooks.



## AN ARTY OPEN HOUSE

Brighton's AT Open House is part of a splendid initiative – a 'residential gallery' series of events. Charlotte Rivers visited

**!** Twice a year thorough the months of May and December, Brighton plays host to a series of Open Houses. It's a great way for local creatives to showcase their work (and for people like us to see it).

We popped along to AT Open House, which you'll find on Hendon Street in the Queens Park area of Brighton. Run by April Williams and Tim Jukes (hence the name 'AT') they first opened their front door to the public in

May 2011, and have been enjoying the sharing nature of the event ever since.

Set over three floors of a pretty terraced Victorian house, AT presents a treasure trove of work from Hello Dodo, Winsome and Saucy, and Delicious Industries – all local artists and makers, based in this colourful coastal town.

On arrival (early on the first day of opening), we're greeted by April who tells us that, while the mix of work at AT is eclectic (from graphic-led to craft to mixed media) she and Tim try to ensure that the styles compliment one another. This is immediately evident in the hallway, where we find a beautifully curated selection of prints from local artists hanging on freshly painted white walls; hand-crafted goods adorning small shelves and sideboards. Then there's the screen prints, letter-pressed artwork, cards, vintage prints, paintings and drawings, as well as hand-printed textiles, knitted accessories and jewellery throughout the house.

A burning log fire gives the house a more-than homely feel, and downstairs we're treated to a tempting selection of delicious homemade cakes and a cup of tea. Don't mind if we do.

If that sounds like your sort of day out, AT will be opening its front door again in May 2013, and is well worth a visit if you're in the area. Check the website for more details, and to see which artists they'll be showcasing at their next open day.
